



HOW TO FEED TREATS SAFELY

DON'T

hold the treat in your fingers. The horse might get your fingers by mistake!

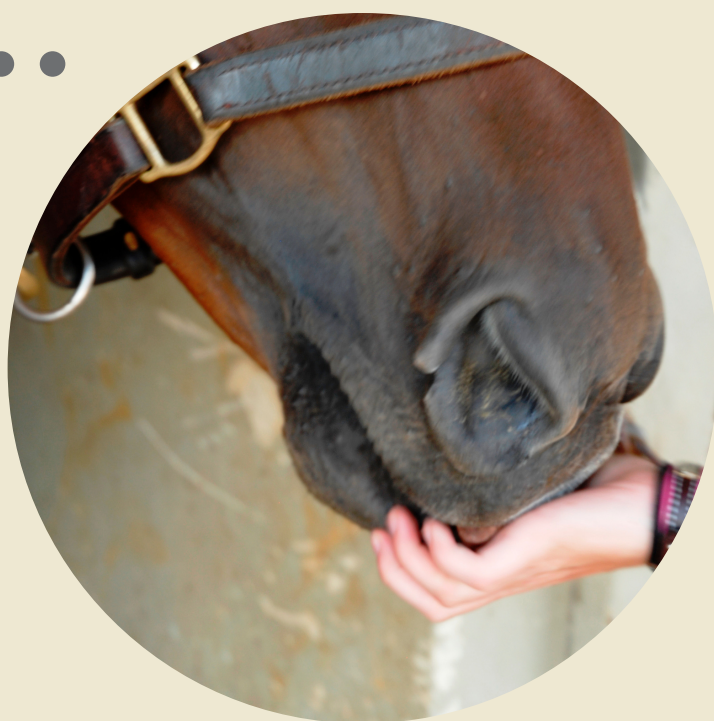


DO

put the treat on the palm of your hand and keep your hand flat as you hold it up to the horse's lips.

DON'T

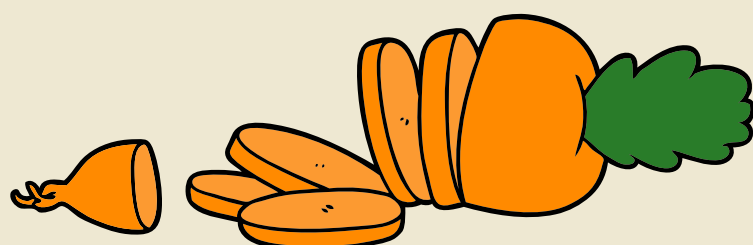
curl your fingers! Remember to keep your hand **FLAT**.



DO

give treats in a feed bucket for horses that get nippy or can't mind their manners around treats.

Cut carrots and apples into bite-size pieces.

HORSE TREAT TIPS



DON'T

take treats out into a herd of horses. You could get hurt if the horses start fighting over the treats.



DO

make sure the treats you feed are safe and healthy for horses. Feed treats in moderation.

DON'T

let your horse eat with a bit in his mouth—the bit can make it hard to chew properly. (It also makes a mess to clean off your bridle and bit.)



DO

ask permission before feeding treats. Some horses might have health issues or be on a special diet.
