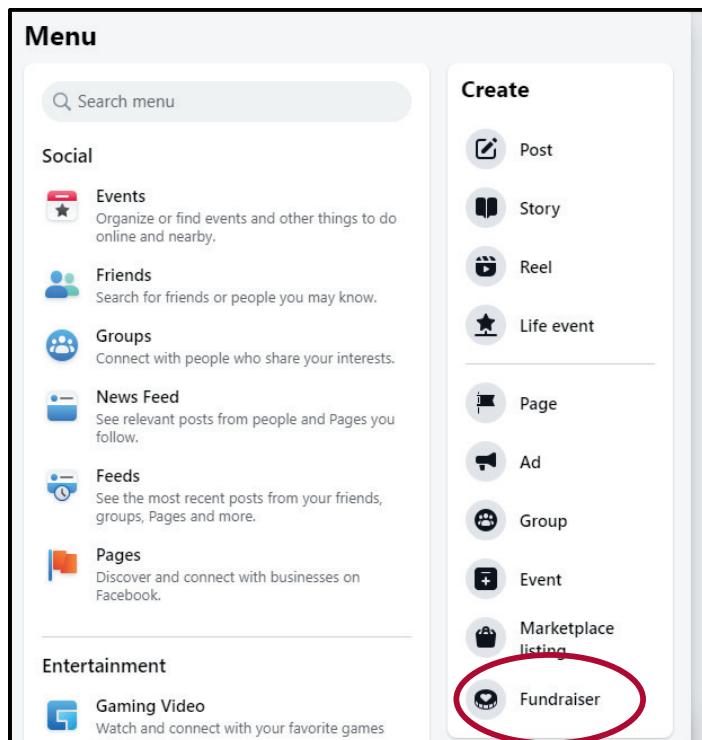
How to Hold a Facebook Fundraiser

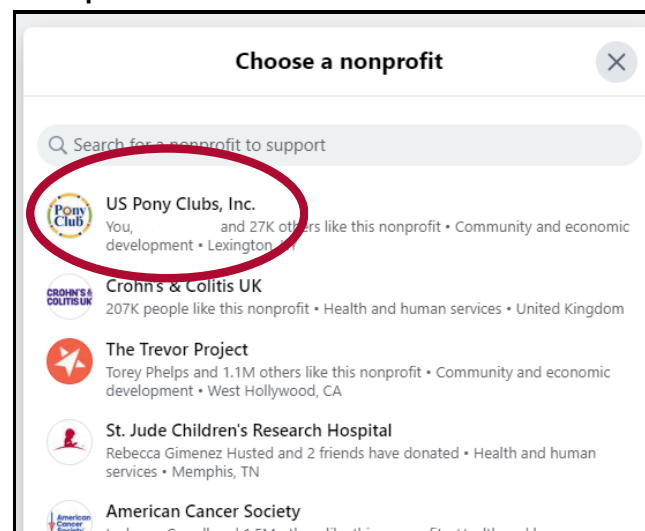
Step 1: Log in to your Facebook account, and in the top right corner, you will see these icons.
